

About the Pegasus Star Calendar 2020...

The Pegasus Star Calendar is a simple and practical aid to know the Star that overlights our SunStar for the appointed day...for birthdays, special events, projects, prayer, etc...

The Pegasus Star Calendar hopes to inspire awe, wonder and gratitude for the Stars and their gifts of love and light that they offer freely to Humanity... for the highest good of all...

The Pegasus Star Calendar is based on the Sidereal Zodiac.

The Sidereal Zodiac shows the Stars' true locations in the heavens, as they are now, in *real time*.

The Stars' true locations are determined by their sidereal geocentric longitude, which is "measured by means of the apparent daily motion of the stars". 1. www.thefreedictionary.co

The Sidereal Zodiac is in true alignment with the placements of Stars and Constellations in *real time sky*. This true alignment reveals how the overlighting Stars stream forth light of blessings and capacities directly to our Sun Star and Humanity via the sidereal lines of longitude/ the cosmic meridians!

The Sidereal Zodiac is often compared to the Tropical Zodiac.

The Tropical Zodiac *remembers* the Stars' positions in the heavens as they were almost 2000 years ago. At that time, The Tropical Zodiac was set to the sidereal Vernal Point. This means that Tropical Zodiac aligned with the Earth's seasons. But, the Vernal Point moves very slowly back over time, about 1 degree every 72 years. This is called the "precession of the equinoxes". Because of the "precession", there is currently a 24 - 25 degree difference and a 24 - 25 day lag between the tropical and sidereal zodiacs. It follows that the Tropical Zodiac no longer corresponds with the true placements and cosmic meridians of Stars and Constellations in real time sky.

Making Use of the Pegasus Star Calendar...

Star Calendar Chart: Gives the daily sidereal geocentric position of the Sun, set at Midnight GMT.
Designates the Stars that directly overlight the Sun daily.
Suggests Blessings/ Capacities offered by the Stars, channeled by Hilarion
in *Starlight Elixirs & Cosmic Vibrational Healing*.

Star Calendar List: Provides the same information as described above.
Gives Bayer Designation and abbreviated home Constellation for each Star.
Indicates the sidereal longitude for each Star.
